

MERGER NOTICE NO 25: 2026

THE PROPOSED ACQUISITION OF 100% OF THE SHARES AND CLAIMS IN DIMENSION DATA BOTSWANA BY ELEMENT TECHNOLOGIES PROPRIETARY LIMITED

Pursuant to section 49(1) of the Competition Act 2018 (the “Act”), the Competition and Consumer Authority (“the Authority”) has received a merger notification for the proposed acquisition of 100% of the issued shares and claims in Dimension Data Botswana (“Dimension Data” or the “Target Enterprise”) by Element Technologies Proprietary Limited (“Element Technologies” or the “Acquiring Enterprise”) [the “Proposed Transaction”]. Post-implementation of the Proposed Transaction, the Acquiring Enterprise will acquire full ownership and control of the Target Enterprise.

The Acquiring Enterprise is a newly incorporated company established in accordance with the Laws of Botswana. Element Technologies is owned by Datashift Proprietary Limited (“Datashift”) and Innolead Consulting Proprietary Limited (“Innolead Consulting”), both incorporated in Botswana. Datashift is a newly incorporated company, formed specifically for the acquisition of the Target Enterprise, whereas Innolead Consulting is involved in project management, strategy and business transformation consultancy. Element Technologies currently has no business activities.

The Directors of Element Technologies are Gosekwang Bokang Keitirile, Michael Kgengwenyane, Onnayang Marumo, Chilipi Tefo Mogasha and Ditiro Ohlson Seralanyane. The Directors of Datashift are Gosekwang Bokang Keitirile, Onnayang Marumo and Ditiro Ohlson Seralanyane. The Director of Innolead Consulting is Michael Kgengwenyane.

The Target Enterprise is a private company duly incorporated in accordance with the laws of Botswana. The Target Enterprise is a wholly owned by Dimension Data Middle East and Africa Proprietary Limited (“DD-MEA”), an NTT Limited company. DD-MEA is a company duly incorporated in South Africa.

Dimension Data is a system integrator providing services spanning networking, cloud computing, cybersecurity, end-user computing, customer experience and data centre infrastructure. Its services continuum includes IT consulting, systems design, implementation, technical support and managed services for enterprises and public sector clients.

The Directors of Dimension Data are Sherrard Mehesh Govender, Onnayang Marumo and Rebecca Louise Pole.

According to section 50 (3) of the Act, “any person, including a third party not a party to the proposed merger, may voluntarily submit to the investigator or the Authority any document, affidavit, statement or other relevant information in respect of a proposed merger.”

The Authority therefore seeks any stakeholder views for or against the proposed merger, which may be sent within 10 days from the date of this publication to the following address:
